

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ATTENDING THE CONFERENCE**CyberTek Tech Festival**

May 14-16, 2024.

§ 1**General Provisions**

1. These Regulations are addressed to all persons participating in the conference entitled: 'CyberTek Tech Festival' (hereinafter referred to as 'the Conference' or 'the Event'), held on 14-16.05.2024 at Muzeum Śląskie in Katowice, ul. Dobrowolskiego 1, 40-205 Katowice by TEKNISKA POLSKA PRZEMYSŁOWE SYSTEMY TRANSMISJI DANYCH SP Z O O (KRS: 0000383694, NIP: 6312631825, REGON: 241922862), registered in the District Court in Gliwice, X Economic Division of the National Court Register, based in Gliwice, ul. Łabędzka 9-9A, 44-121 Gliwice, with the initial capital of PLN 50,000, hereinafter referred to as 'the Organizer'.
2. Any person who has registered for the Conference or who is in the area where the Conference is being held is bound to comply with the provisions of these Regulations.
3. The purpose of the Regulations is to ensure the safety of the Conference by setting out the rules of conduct for the people present at the Conference and their use of the premises where the Conference is being hosted on 14-16 May 2024, as well as the facilities located therein, and furthermore to regulate the rights and obligations of the Conference Participants.
4. The following terms used in the Regulations will have the following meanings:
 - 'Law Enforcement Services' and 'Information Services' means the persons designated to take care of the safety of persons attending the Conference, such as checking the authorization of Conference Participants to enter the Conference premises.
 - 'Conference premises' means the location where the Conference is held. The venue may be changed for valid reasons and made public prior to the Conference.
 - 'Conference Participant' or 'Participant' means a person attending the Conference upon prior registration.

§ 2**Terms and conditions of participation**

1. Participants can enter the Conference by registering beforehand at <https://eventory.cc/event/cybertek-tech-festival/tickets> and accepting these Regulations.
2. Registration will be open until 13 May 2024.
3. The number of Participants at the Conference is limited.
4. Attendance at the Conference is determined by the order of registration.
5. Participants' admission to the Conference is paid. Ticket prices are listed at www.cybertek.com.pl.
6. The Participant is obliged to immediately notify the Organizer about resignation from attending the Conference by sending an email to: konferencja@cybertek.com.pl.



§ 3**General Data Protection Regulation (RODO)
- Information Clause**

1. Pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (Official Journal of the EU. L. of 2016 No. 119, p. 1 as amended) (hereinafter referred to as RODO/GDPR, the Organizer hereby informs that:

The co-administrators of the personal data with the optional consent of the Participant given in the application form are the Conference Partners. The list of Conference Partners can be accessed on the Conference website (<https://cybertek.com.pl/>).

2. The personal data of the Participants will be processed:

- pursuant to Article 6(1)(a) RODO (GDPR) in conjunction with Article 81 of the Act on Copyright and Related Rights in order to promote the Controller's activities and build a positive image of the Controller in the scope of free of charge distribution of the Participants' image on the Controller's website and in the Controller's social media related to the organization, participation, reporting on the course and documentation of the Conference upon freely given consent,
- pursuant to Article 6(1)(b) of the RODO (GDPR) in order to organize the Conference, register and participate in the Conference, including drawing up lists of Participants, concluding and implementing the provisions of these Rules and Regulations to which the Participant is a party,
- pursuant to Article 6(1) (f) of the RODO (GDPR) in order to assert or defend against possible claims.

3. The Participant's submission of personal data is voluntary; however, it is a necessary condition for attending the Conference. Refusal to provide data to the extent necessary to join or hold the Conference and to the extent required by law will preclude participation in the Conference.

4. Consent to the unpaid distribution of your image is voluntary, however, it is a condition of participation in the Conference.

5. The participant is entitled to:

- (a) have access to the content of their data,
- (b) correct inaccurate or incomplete data,
- (c) delete or limit the processing of their data,
- (d) transfer data to another Controller or to themselves.
- (e) withdraw their consent at any time if the processing of personal data by the Controller is based on consent, whereby the withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of the processing carried out based on consent before its withdrawal.



6. The Participant reserves the right to object to the processing of personal data that is not based on the Participant's consent, a contract, or a provision of law. If an objection is lodged after the Participant's request has been considered, it will not be possible for the Controller to process the personal data covered by the objection unless the Controller demonstrates that there are valid legitimate grounds for the processing of the data, which are deemed by law to override the Participants' interests, rights and freedoms, or there are reasons to establish, assert or defend claims.

7. The Controller will collect the following data from Participants, including personal details: Participant's name, Participant's phone number, Participant's email address, function/position, and company.

8. The Participant's personal data will be processed until the end of the Conference. Moreover, the data may be processed for marketing purposes until the Participant withdraws their consent. The data storage period may be extended each time by the period of the expiry of the claim if the data processing is necessary for the Organizer to investigate claims or to defend against such claims. The data may be processed for the period necessary to fulfill the Organizer's obligations under accounting and tax regulations.

9. The participant holds the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for the Protection of Personal Data about violations of data protection regulations.

§ 4

Personal data protection - distribution of participants' images

1. The personal data specified by Participants will be stored in a manner that prevents disclosure and is processed in compliance with the provisions of RODO (GDPR)

2. The Organizer hereby advises Participants that the Conference will be recorded. The legal grounds for the processing of personal data in the form of an image are indicated in the information clause in § 3 above. The processing of personal data in the form of images will take place pursuant to the consent of Article 6(1) (a) of RODO (GDPR) in connection with Article 81 of the Act of 4 February 1994 on Copyright and Related Rights (i.e. Journal of Laws of 2021, item 1062).

3. Upon registration, in accordance with § 2, section 1 above, the Conference Participant agrees to the processing of personal data contained in the registration form by Tekniska Polska Sp. z o.o. and other authorized entities for purposes related to the organization of and participation in the Conference.

4. During the Conference, the Organizer may hold photo sessions and film the course of the Conference for the purpose of broadcasting in the mass media (television, radio, Internet, press) or for the purpose of documenting, promoting, advertising the Organizer and other persons indicated by the Organizer. Participation in the Conference is deemed equivalent to the Participant's consent for the Organizer and



related entities to record, use, and/or disseminate the Participants' image in promotional and marketing materials, without time and territorial limitations. These materials can only be used for the purpose of promoting the Conference and its subsequent editions in a professional manner.

5. By giving consent, photographs, films, or recordings obtained during the Conference may be uploaded to the Organizer's website or any other website operated by the Organizer (e.g. social networking sites) and used in promotional materials. **The participant hereby waives all claims (existing and future), including claims for damages against the Organizer for the use of their image for the purposes set out in these Regulations.**

§ 5

Organization and Conference program

1. The current agenda for the Conference will be made available to Participants electronically at www.cybertek.com.pl. The Organizer reserves the right to change the agenda.
2. The Organizer shall not be held responsible for items belonging to Participants that are lost, damaged, or stolen during the Conference.
3. The Conference participants are obliged to behave in a manner that does not jeopardize the safety of others, in particular, to observe safety rules, including health and safety regulations, fire regulations, as well as instructions and organizational and technical instructions of the Organizer's representative.
4. The Organizer shall not be liable for any damage caused by the Participants' conduct during the Conference in breach of the law or the Regulations.
5. The participant of the Conference shall be fully accountable, both legally and financially, for damages caused by their action or omission.
6. The Organizer shall not be liable for any damage incurred by Participants arising from the organization, conduct, cancellation, or postponement of the Conference.
7. The Organizer shall not be deemed liable for improper performance or non-performance to the extent that this is caused by force majeure. Force majeure shall be construed as unforeseeable external events, beyond the control of the contracting parties.

§ 6

Final Provisions

1. The Organizer shall provide a supply of parking spaces at the venue.



2. The travel expenses related to the Conference are to be covered by the Participants themselves.

4. The Organizer does not provide accommodation. Participants may arrange accommodation on their own.
5. In cases beyond the Organizer's control due to force majeure, the Organizer may decide to cancel the Conference or reschedule it.
6. The Organizer reserves the right to change the provisions of these Regulations. The Organizer reserves the right to use the e-mail address provided during registration for the Conference to notify Conference Participants, among other things, of changes to the Conference program (agenda), Regulations, or subsequent Conferences.
7. All doubts concerning the rules of the Conference, its Regulation provisions and interpretations, as well as situations not covered by these Regulations shall be resolved by the Organizer.
8. All legal relations arising in connection with the organization of and participation in the Conference shall at all times be subject to Polish law.
9. Any disputes that may arise from the participation in the Conference shall be settled by the court competent for the registered office of the Organizer.
