

**CONFERENCE PARTICIPATION
REGULATIONS****CyberTek Technology Festival**

May 27-29, 2025

§ 1**General Provisions**

1. The implementing regulations are for all persons participating in the conference entitled "CyberTek Tech Festival" (hereinafter referred to as the Conference or event), held on May 27-29, 2025 at the Silesian Museum in Katowice, ul. Dobrowolskiego 1, 40-205 Katowice by **TEKNISKA POLSKA PRZEMYSŁOWE SYSTEMY TRANSMISJI DANYCH SP Z O O** (KRS: 0000383694, NIP: 6312631825, REGON: 241922862), registered in the District Court in Gliwice, 10th Commercial Division of the National Court Register, with its registered office in Gliwice, ul. Łabędzka 9-9A, 44-121 Gliwice, with a founding capital of PLN 50,000, referred to in the specified part as the organizer.

2. The person responsible who submits the application for the Conference or who is present in the area where the mandatory principle is applied to the provisions of the Regulations.

3. The purpose of the Regulations is to ensure the safety of the Conference by introducing rules of conduct for persons present at the Conference and their use of the area where services can be used on May 27-29, 2025. This is a Conference that is also applied there, and is also controlled and monitored by the Conference participants.

4. The following rules of application will be disclosed:

- "security services" and "information services" mean a person responsible for ensuring the safety of persons at the Conference, including checking the rights of Conference Participants to enter the Conference area.
- "conference area" means the place where the conference is located. The place may contain reservations and be made public before the conference.
- "Conference Participant" or "Participant" means a person entering the Conference based on a previously submitted application.

§ 2**Conditions of operation**

1. Participants may enter the Conference after previously registering at <https://eventory.cc/event/cybertek-tech-festival/tickets> and accepting compliance with the Regulations.

2. Registration can be made on May 23, 2025 the latest.

3. The number of Conference Participants is limited.

4. About the possibility of making a decision on submitting an application.

5. Entry for Participants to the Conference is subject to a fee. Ticket prices are available on the website www.cybertek.com.pl

§ 3

Protection of personal data - Information clause

1. In accordance with art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the use of personal data and on the free access to such data and the use of services 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (OJ EU. L. of 2016 No. 119, p. 1 with subsequent amendments) (referred to in a limited scope as part of the GDPR), the Organizer of the organization, that: The co-administrators of the personal data for the optional discipline of the Participant provided in the application form are the Conference Partners. The list of Conference Partners is available on the Conference website (<https://cybertek.com.pl/>).

2. Personal data of participants will be processed:

- pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 of the GDPR in connection with art. 81 of the Act on Copyright and Related Rights for the purpose of promoting the activities and possession of the Administrator's image in the scope of free appearance of participants on the Administrator's website and in the Administrator's social media related to, achieved, reporting on the course and documenting the Conference at the request of the expressed consent,
- pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 letter b of the GDPR for the purpose of organizing the Conference, registered and participation in the Conference, including drawing up a list of participants, introducing and enforcing compliance with the Regulations, of which the participant is the controller,
- pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 letter f of the GDPR for the purpose of legal proceedings or against possible claims.

3. Providing personal data by the participant is required, however, it is necessary to participate in the Conference. Refusal to provide data within the scope of joining or implementing the Conference and within the scope required by law, which will prevent participation in the Conference.

4. Exclusion of consent to free admission is a condition, but it constitutes a conditio of participation in the Conference.

5. The Participant has the right to:

- a) access the content of their data,
- b) correct installations or incomplete data,
- c) delete or limit data processing,
- d) contact details to another Administrator or to you,
- e) withdraw consent at the time of immediate cessation of personal data processing by the Administrator based on consent, and the withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of the processing carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.

6. The Participant has the right to object to the processing of personal data that is not based on the Participant's consent, an agreement or a provision of law. In the event of an objection after considering the Participant's application, it will not be possible for the Administrator to process the personal data covered by the objection, unless the Administrator demonstrates that there are valid legally justified grounds for processing the data that are considered by law to be superior to the interests, rights and freedoms of the Participants or there are grounds for establishing, pursuing or defending claims.

7. The Administrator will collect the following information from Participants, including personal data: Participant's name and surname, Participant's contact telephone number, Participant's e-mail address, function/position, company.

8. The Participant's personal data will be processed until the end of the Conference. The data may also be processed for marketing purposes until the Participant withdraws consent. The data storage period may be extended each time by the limitation period for claims, if data processing is necessary for the Organizer to pursue claims or defend against such claims. Data may be processed for the period necessary to fulfill the obligations incumbent on the Organizer resulting from accounting and tax regulations.

9. The Participant has the right to file a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office regarding violations of the provisions on personal data protection.

§ 4

Personal data protection – dissemination of Participants' image

1. Personal data indicated by Participants will be stored in a manner that protects against their disclosure and processed in accordance with the provisions of the GDPR.

2. The Organizer hereby informs Participants that the Conference will be recorded. The legal basis for processing personal data in the form of an image has been indicated in the information clause in § 3 above. The processing of personal data in the form of an image will be carried out on the basis of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (OJ EU.L.2016.119.1 of 2016.05.04) and the Act of 4 February 1994 on copyright and related rights (OJ 2022.2509 consolidated text of 2022.12.06).

3. Upon registration in accordance with § 2 sec. 1 above, the Conference Participant consents to the processing of personal data contained in the registration form by Tekniska Polska Sp. z o.o. and other authorized entities for purposes related to the organization and participation in the Conference.

4. During the Conference, the Organizer may conduct photo sessions and film the course of the Conference for the purposes of broadcasting in the mass media (television, radio, Internet, press) or for the purposes of documentation, promotion, advertising of the Organizer and other persons indicated by the Organizer. Participation in the Conference is tantamount to the expression of the Participant's consent to the recording, use and/or distribution by the Organizer and entities associated with it of the image of the Participants in promotional and marketing materials without time or territorial limits. These materials may be used only for the purpose of promoting the Conference and its subsequent editions in a professional manner.

5. Expressing consent is tantamount to the fact that photographs, films or recordings taken during the Conference may be placed on the Organizer's website or another website managed by it (e.g. social networking sites) and used in promotional materials. The Participant hereby waives all claims (existing and future), including compensation against the Organizer, for the use of his image for the purposes specified in these Regulations.

§ 5

Organization and course of the Conference

1. The current agenda of the Conference will be made available to Participants electronically on the website www.cybertek.com.pl. The Organizer reserves the right to change the agenda.
2. The Organizer is not responsible for items belonging to Participants that are lost, destroyed or stolen during the Conference.
3. Conference Participants are obliged to behave in a way that does not endanger the safety of other people, in particular to comply with safety rules, including health and safety regulations, fire protection, as well as organizational and technical instructions and orders of the Organizer's representative.
4. The Organizer is not responsible for any damage caused as a result of Participants' conduct during the Conference in a manner inconsistent with the law or the Regulations.
5. The Conference Participant bears full responsibility for legal and financial liability for damages caused by its action or omission.
6. The Organizer shall not be liable for damages incurred by Participants in connection with the organization, course, cancellation or postponement of the Conference.
7. The Organizer shall not be liable for improper performance or failure to perform obligations to the extent that it was caused by force majeure. Force majeure shall be understood as external events, beyond the control of the parties to the contract and unforeseeable.

§ 6

Final provisions

1. The Organizer shall provide a pool of parking spaces at the event location (50 parking spaces in the underground car park).
2. The Participant shall cover the cost of travel to the Conference on their own.

The Organizer reserves the right to use the e-mail address provided during registration for the Conference to notify Conference Participants, among others, about changes to the Conference program (agenda), Regulations or subsequent Conferences.
